**slate**

a small chalkboard, framed in wood, used in one-room schools instead of writing paper

**arithmetic**

another word for math  
(counting and calculating numbers)

**wood stove**

a stove that used wood and fire to warm a classroom in a one-room school

**outhouse**

a small, outdoor building used as a restroom before indoor plumbing was available

**nooning**

an old term for lunch recess; a meal or rest at midday
